	The Chairperson took the potential Bidders through the three tender evaluation stages and four steps applicable to this bid.	
5.2	Technical/ Functionality	TNPA End- user
	 TNPA End-user provided a detailed overview of the criteria's of the technical evaluation and urged bidders to pay attention when compiling information required on each category in order to maximise opportunity to score higher points. Bidders are required to meet the Minimum Threshold of 70.00 points to proceed to the last stage of evaluation. 	
5.3	Pricing and Delivery Schedule	
	The pricing schedule is not applicable at this stage, however bidders are required to fully complete subsection 2 and note the utilisation of the pool clauses.	
5.4	List Of Returnable Documents	SCM
	 The Chairperson took the potential Bidders through the mandatory returnable document, returnable documents used for scoring and essential returnable documents. The Chairperson further emphasized that failure to submit the mandatory documents will lead to the disqualification of a Bidder. 	
6.	Tender Submission	SCM
	The Chairperson took the potential Bidders through the submission of bids and advised bidders to only submit completed bids to e-Tender Submission Portal, TNPA will not accept any bids that are hand delivered or submitted through email.
