Eskom Holdings SOC Ltd (hereinafter "Eskom") invites you to submit a tender for the Supply and delivery of Double Loop Bird Flight Diverters via the Reverse E Auction Platform for a period of 12 Months to various Eskom Transmission Southern Grid sites (Eastern Cape & Free State).

Tenderers must not in any way contact any Eskom employee who is involved in the tender during the tender process, either telephonically, by email or through private appointments before and after submitting tenders.
