While crushing is taking place, all other employees should make sure that the removal of contaminants are removed and separated as required. When crushing is done, comping of stockpile must be done. All contractors shall work within the parameter of the job description and scope of work. To keep all instructions/ procedures on hand and supply Eskom power station with references to be included in this document and supply record and history requirements. Contractors must also ensure that the work is performed to the highest standard and safety standards and regulations.
