#### 4. EVALUATION OF THE BID

The following evaluation method will be used:

- After the closing date of the bid invitation, an appointed bid evaluation committee of Nongoma Local Municipality will evaluate the proposals of the bidders.
- The committee will individually evaluate each of the bid proposals received against the approved criteria as stated below.
- All proposals submitted will be evaluated on two (2) categories:
  - ➤ Mandatory returnable documents
  - > Functionality (technical content)

#### The evaluation of the bids will be conducted in the following two (2) stages:

STAGE 1: Bidders who did not submit all returnable documents will be disqualified for further evaluation.

STAGE 2: The assessment of functionality must be done in terms of the evaluation criteria and minimum threshold value of **70 points**. A bid will be disqualified if it fails to meet the minimum threshold for functionality as per the bid invitation.

#### **Certificate of Independent Bid Determination**

- 1 This Municipal Bidding Document (MBD) must form part of all bids<sup>1</sup> invited.
- Section 4 (1) (b) (iii) of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998, as amended, prohibits an agreement between, or concerted practice by, firms, or a decision by an association of firms, if it is between parties in a horizontal relationship and if it involves collusive bidding (or bid rigging).<sup>2</sup> Collusive bidding is a *pe se* prohibition meaning that it cannot be justified under any grounds.
