PART 4: SITE INFORMATION

1. General description

The works will be done in Transmission's Central Grid Olympus Substation which is located in Vanderbijlpark, Gauteng Province in South Africa. The training will be provided by the Employers Safety and Security officers before commencement of any work on site.
