The fee is payable at the cashier offices at the Municipal offices in Kerk Street Malmesbury. Only cash will be accepted. No electronic transfers will be accepted. There will be no clarification meeting.

Tenders and all relevant documentation must be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked "Formal Tender T06.23.24 – TRANSPORT OF CONTAINERISED MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE FROM THE RIEBEECK WEST SOLID WASTE DROP-OFF FOR A CONTRACT PERIOD ENDING ENDING 30 JUNE 2027", together with the name and contact details of bidder on the envelope. Envelopes must be deposited in the tender box at the Municipal Head Offices, on the cnr of Kerk and Voortrekker Streets, Malmesbury, before <u>12h00</u> on <u>Friday 12 April 2024</u>. Envelopes without the required information will be regarded as non-conforming and will be rejected.

Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the Council's Preferential Procurement Policy and the attached specifications. The 80/20-preference point system will be used for the evaluation of the contract. The Preferential Procurement Policy will be available for perusal during normal office hours at the municipal offices.

The Swartland Municipality endorses and supports the Government's Black Economic Empowerment Programme and is committed to rectify the inequalities of the past. For bidders to qualify for the advantages of the B-BBEE Act, they must thoroughly complete the attached Annexure MBD 6.1. <u>There will be no benefits if the schedule is not thoroughly</u> <u>completed. Preference points MUST also be claimed in paragraph 6.1</u>. Bidders are required to submit original and valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or certified copies thereof together with their bids, to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims. Bidders are also required to submit Proof of Locality in order to claim points for locality.

Late tenders will not be accepted and the Municipality will not be compelled to accept the lowest or any tender. The Municipality reserves the right to omit any part of the tender. Tenders by telephone, facsimile and e-mail will not be accepted.
