- 4.4 Respondents found to be in collusion with one another will be automatically disqualified and restricted from doing business with organs of state for a specified period.
- 4.5 Transnet will publish the outcome of this RFP in the National Treasury e-tender portal and Transnet website with 10 days after the award has been finalised. Respondents are required to check the National Treasury e-tender Portal and Transnet website for the results of the tender process. #### 6 COMPLIANCE

The successful Respondent [hereinafter referred to as the **Supplier/Service provider**] shall be in full and complete compliance with any and all applicable laws and regulations.

### 7 EMPLOYMENT EQUITY ACT

#### 8 DISCLAIMERS

- 8.2 reject any Proposal which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein;
- 8.3 disqualify Proposals submitted after the stated submission deadline [closing date];
- 8.4 award a contract in connection with this Proposal at any time after the RFP's closing date;
- 8.5 award a contract for only a portion of the proposed Goods/Services which are reflected in the scope of this RFP;
- 8.6 split the award of the contract between more than one Supplier/Service provider, should it at Transnet's discretion be more advantageous in terms of, amongst others, cost or developmental considerations;
- 8.7 cancel the bid process;

#### 9 LEGAL REVIEW

A Proposal submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business. #### 10 SECURITY CLEARANCE



Furthermore, Transnet will not otherwise modify, amend or alter any personal data submitted by the Respondent or disclose or permit the disclosure of any personal data to any third party without the prior written consent from the Respondent. - 8.
