### **T 39 OF 2023/24: REHABILITATION OF HORNLEE INTERNAL STREETS AND RELATED INFRASTRUCTURE – CONTRACT 03**

Knysna Municipality hereby invites contractors to submit tenders for the Rehabilitation of Hornlee Internal Streets and Related Infrastructure.

Contractors must have a minimum CIDB grading of **5CE** or higher.

A compulsory briefing session will be held on **4TH April 2024 at 10h00 at the Knysna Municipal Green Stores, Corner of George Rex Drive and Marlin Road, Knysna**. All attendees must sign the attendance register, failing which their relevant tenders will be deemed non-responsive. One Company representative allowed to sign the register.

The evaluation of this bid will be subjected to functionality scoring. Tenderers must achieve a minimum functionality score of **70 out of 100** for functionality in order to be evaluated further on price and preference point systems. The functionality criteria and weighting are set out in the tender document.

Bids will be evaluated according to the **80/20** preference points system. The bids are subject to the Council Supply Chain Management Policy, Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000, and the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022. The MFMA Circular 90, The Tender Data, The General Conditions of Contract (GCC) and, if applicable, any other Special Conditions of Contract

One (1) copy, the original tender documents and USB Memory Stick with whole scanned tender document including returnable schedules and appendices must be placed in a sealed envelope and clearly marked **“REHABILITATION OF HORNLEE INTERNAL STREETS AND RELATED INFRASTRUCTURE – CONTRACT 03 (Contract No: T39 OF 2023/2024)”** and are to be placed in the Municipality tender box at office of the Knysna Municipality, Supply Chain Management Unit, Finance Building, Queen Street, Knysna. The closing date and time for submissions is 26th April 2024 at 12h00, where after received tenders will be publicly opened.

Late and incomplete Tenders will not be accepted. The only or lowest Tender will not necessarily be accepted and the Municipality reserves the right to accept the whole or any portion of a bids, or not to make an appointment.

**No verbal and / or telephonic queries and clarifications will be entertained by the Agency and must instead be made in writing and will be responded to accordingly. The Municipality reserves the right to circulate the questions and answers to all registered parties in the form of a tender bulletin.
