NECSA SAFETY, HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Management and employees of Necsa are committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for its employees, visitors and the public and to manage the environmental impacts of their nuclear, chemical and related activities, products and services. Management has a leadership role in the communication and implementation of, and ensuring compliance with, SHEQ policies and standards.

- Necsa continually strives to improve the SHE Management System and performance by:
- 1.1 Keeping exposure to radiation as low as reasonably achievable (ALARA);
- 1.2 Actively reducing the number of SHE related incidents and public concerns;
- 1.3 Identifying and removing barriers to safe behaviour;
- 1.4 Providing emergency planning and response services;
- 1.5 Preventing pollution of soil, water and air by eliminating or minimizing waste, effluent and emissions
- 1.6 Re-useing, reducing and recycling of materials;
- 1.7 Conserving fauna and flora, energy, water and other resources; and
- 1.8 Regularly reviewing SHE performance.
- Necsa shall comply with applicable legal and other requirements that relate to hazards and aspects by:
- 2.1 Conducting risk & impact assessments prior to establishing new facilities or modifying existing ones;
- 2.2 Monitoring the workplace, conducting audits, taking appropriate corrective actions; and
- 2.3 Maintaining product stewardship by taking responsibility for the full life-cycle of products.
- The SHE Management System shall provide a framework for setting and reviewing objectives and targets by:
- 3.1 Establishing and measuring annual SHEQ performance objectives and targets; and
- 3.2 Providing the necessary resources to achieve these goals.
- The SHE Management System shall be established, documented, implemented and maintained through integration of the SHE risks and aspects into business and other activities by:
- 4.1 Using an integrated process based management system, to ensure sustainable development; and
- 4.2 Utilising the Behavioural Based Safety (BBS) process to create and foster a positive safety culture.
- All persons working under the control of, or on behalf of Necsa shall be made aware of their individual obligations and responsibilities by:
- 5.1 Providing communication, awareness, motivation, training, commitment, involvement of staff; and
- 5.2 Including SHE aspects in the strategic choices of current and new business areas.
- 6 Necsa promotes open communication on SHE activities as information is available on request to interested parties and the public:
- 6.1 Disclosing all related incidents and information at regular community forum meetings;
- 6.2 Interacting timeously with authorities and the public regarding SHE matters; and
- 6.3 Promoting awareness among staff, contractors, suppliers, lessees, clients and the community.

Management shall ensure the SHE Policy is communicated to personnel and is periodically reviewed for continuing suitability to Necsa operations. Management through leadership and active involvement will demonstrate adherence to this Policy.
