#### TERMS OF REFERENCE/SCOPE OF WORK

#### **CLEARFELLING OF TREES ON FLAT SLOPE AREAS**

Quote in R/m³ to supply 1x cable skidder team to produce approximately 5400m³ of pine clearfell with a tree size of approximately 1.00m³ and bigger

The service shall include the felling, de branching, extraction, merchandising and cross cutting according to required saw log lengths and client specifications, stacking of products separately at road side. The required service shall comply to Safcol's BOP's and forest management procedures.

#### 1. PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND BACKGROUND

Uitsoek Plantation situated on the Sudwala Caves Road, Mpumalanga currently require the services of a clear-felling contractor to work on the moderate to flat areas in the plantation. The service provider must produce about 5400m³ in clear felling compartment. It must be noted that the volumes depicted are an estimation and may change with operational requirements and cannot be guaranteed.

#### 2. SCOPE OF WORK

Clearfelling will be prepared by the service provider in required products according the client` and KLF`s specifications. Service provider to make use of a cable skidderto extract long length from the compartment to roadside.

Volume to be invoiced will be recorded once it is presented at roadside.

The required work will be mainly clearfelling trees with an average tree volume of 1.00m3.

The required work will consist of the following:

- Clearfelling of trees on Flat slope areas
- Fell, debranch, log scale and x cut of trees into required products
- Stacking of separate products into required stacks sizes at road side
- All work will be according to the KLF policies and procedures available from the harvesting manager
- Daily required production of about 160m3

The required team need to consist of the approximately the following people:

- 5 chainsaw operators with functional chainsaws
- 1 knowledgable and trained cable skidder operator
- 1 knowledgable and trained bell operator with a functional bell logger machine
- 1 logscalers
- 4 chockermans to chock and dechock for the skidder
- At least one supervisor
- At least one she rep and one first aider in the team team will not be allowed to operate if first aider, first aid bag (comply with SAFCOL procedure) and she rep is absent
  - 2.1 Required specification for the requested work:
- Only qualified chainsaw operators will be allowed on KLF plantations to perform the work, certificates to be provided
- Transport to comply to all required policies and procedures and must be roadworthy and have an enclosed Canopy with roll over protection
- The prospective bidder to ensure that all drivers have a valid Driver's License and Public Driver Permit (PrDP) for drivers transporting people
- Appropriate PPE for all team members
- Trained first aider (level 2) and she rep with valid certificate and first aid box
- Immediate availability to commence work as soon as possible
- Minimum wage and more to be paid to employees
- That employees be in possession of a valid South African Identity document or work permit
- Be compliant with all labour legislation.
- That labour shall be paid at least the minimum wage as per the sectoral determination or as gazette by government from time to time
- That labour be in possession of a valid employment contract compliant to the minimum requirements on employment legislation
- Comply with statutory deductions
- That labour has been trained for the specific job and that current Certificates of Training be available.
- Previous experience of harvesting or previous experience of clearfelling and similar projects will be advantageous
- Experienced supervision
- Required equipment to perform the work

#### 2. **DEFINITIONS**

- (a) "tender" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation;
- (b) "price" means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (c) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) "tender for income-generating contracts" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and
