1. INTRODUCTION

Elias Motsoaledi local Municipality intends to appoint a maximum of two (2) service providers for the provision of an Integrated Pest Management Program at all Municipal Offices for a period of 36 (thirty-six) months.

2. BACKGROUND

The Occupational Health and Safety Act (No: 85 of 1993), requires all South African employers to provide a clean, healthy, hygienic and safe working environment. Pest control contributes to a healthy and clean working environment for the benefit of employees and the public in general.

3. SCOPE OF WORK AND DELIVERABLES

- The successful Service Providers shall furnish all supervision, labour, materials, and equipment necessary to accomplish the monitoring, trapping, pesticide application, pest removal and disposal.
- The successful Service Providers shall also provide detailed, site-specific recommendations for structural and procedural modifications to aid in pest prevention.
- The service providers shall use of environmentally friendly methods to control pests in all municipal offices (This
 will enable work to be done during normal working hours)
- The service providers shall minimize the negative impact that may be caused by the pest control services on the environment
- The service providers are required to use the relevant method of pest control in each environment. For example; gel application, spray and etc.
- The service providers shall be required on a monthly basis to put measures to control Indoor and outdoor populations
 of rodents by setting up rodent station as identified by the municipality
- The service providers shall affix water resistant service note on temper-proof bait station that must be updated (as and when required) on service intervals.

6. UNIFORMS AND PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

- All Service Providers personnel working in or around buildings specified in this contract shall wear protective clothing. Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality reserves the right to decline and/ or remove a Service Providers employee not adhering to this requirement.
- The Service Providers shall determine the need for and provide any personal protective items required for the safe performance of work.
- Protective clothing, equipment, and devices shall, as a minimum, conform to Occupational Safety and Health Regulations standards for the products being used.

7. USE OF PESTICIDES

- The Service Providers shall be responsible for the application of pesticides according to the label.
- All pesticides used by the Service Provider must be registered with the Department of Agriculture as stipulated by Act No. 36 of 1947.
- Transport, handling, and use of all pesticides shall be in strict accordance with the manufacturer's label instructions and all applicable local laws and regulations
- The Service Providers shall provide the municipality with current labels and Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for all
 proposed pesticides to be used, brand names of pesticide equipment's, rodent bait boxes and rodent trapping devices,
 pest monitoring devices and other pest control devices that may be required
