Please find below questions and answers for the Briefing held 25 March 2024

- I. Is the Land Bank looking for a detailed technical proposal and is methodology required?
 - a. Metadata will be required for any dataset used in providing the solution
 - b. For any datasets that is compiled as the results of calculations using other datasets, the Land Bank will require formulas peer reviewed and authenticated.
 - c. Training manual is also required
- 2. Is the Land Bank looking for existing system or develop a new system?
 - a. The Land Bank is looking for an already existing system
- 3. There is already some datasets that are readily available such as LandCover and LandUse, can these datasets be used?
 - a. The Land Bank prefers the already published government datasets and the LandCover and LandUse is one of those datasets that have been published
 - b. Where the dataset is not available, the service provide must source the dataset
 - c. As part of governance, the service provider will share the geospatial data (shapefiles) with Land Bank in order to keep for 5 years
- 4. Data sourcing to be conducted by the Land Bank or service provider in the case that the data is not available on the government website
 - a. The service provider to source each data they require in order to provide a solution.
 - b. Where the dataset is not available, the service provide must source the dataset
- 5. Does the Land Bank have any servers or GIS software's
 - a. The Land Bank is look for a solution that is cloud-based, must be end-to-end solution
 - b. The service provider will need to give the Land Bank a link (URL) in order to access their system
