PAVING, RETAING AND LANDSCAPING OF SIZA'ULUTAMBO COMMUNITY HALL

1. SPECIFICATION

The scope of work includes Paving, Retaining and Landscaping of Sizal'uThambo Community Hall.

2. BACKGROUND

SizaluTambo Community Hall in Ward 4 was completed in 2022 and officially handed over. The area the Community Hall is built in has loose soil which lead to the collapse of the donga behind the Community hall leaving the palisade fence hanging.

During heavy rains the community hall front area of the community hall holds water to the extent that the water floods the hall through the side door of the Community Hall. This is a major concern as it has a huge impact on the premature deterioration of the Community Hall which is fairly new.

It is against this background that a Service Provider is required to fix the problem.

3. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Service Provider will be required to undertake the following:

- Paving of the areas in-front and on the side of the Community Hall
- Retaining of donga behind the Community
- Relocate the hanging palisade fence from its original place to a more secure area
- Landscaping of the slanting area to avoid further soil erosion.

4. STRATEGIC OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT

- a) To prevent ill effects of weathering agencies on the sub-grade soil;
- b) To create slanting effect to redirect excess water;
- c) To retain the eroding soil and saving the palisade fencing;

5. SCOPE OF WORK

The Scope of work is detailed in the attached bill of quantities.

6. REPORTING

The Municipality will conduct monthly meeting to track construction progress on site. Furthermore, the Municipality must be updated on a regular basis of any development requiring urgent action or attention by the municipality. Such updates include anything that poses a challenge to the successful completion of the project.

7. SKILLS TRANSFER

Basic skills should be transferred to locally employed un-skilled laborer's as per the Service Providers detailed methodology.

 - (d) recommend that the tenderer or contractor, its shareholders and directors, or only the shareholders and directors who acted on a fraudulent basis, be restricted from obtaining business from any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years, after the audi alteram partem (hear the other side) rule has been applied; and
 - (e) forward the matter for criminal prosecution, if deemed necessary.
