Wolvaardt again underlined her importance to the Proteas and her own increasing confidence as captain with a composed innings, which saw her finish on 110 not out as her team reached a modest target of 230 with 14 balls to spare.

She and Marizanne Kapp shared a partnership of 147 for the fourth wicket, with Kapp scoring an unbeaten 80 off 84 balls, a knock that included seven fours and gave the home team's innings a much-needed boost. Wolvaardt, who was given a life in the first over when she
