# 1.BACKGROUND

Tourism KZN is responsible for promoting the province of KwaZulu-Natal to domestic and international travelers. A key enabler to promote the destination is the use of technology.

# **2.SCOPE OF SERVICES**

- 2.1 Tourism KZN does utilise the Netwrix application software.
- 2.2 The Netwrix application software is installed and operational on an existing server.
- 2.3 The entity has implemented a new server which will require a new instance of Netwrix to be installed and configured on the new server.
- 2.4 All Netwrix data must be migrated to the new instance enabling the existing instance to be decommissioned.
- 2.5 The new Instance will require a license for a period of 12 months as the current license is due for renewal.
- 2.6 Based on the recent changes in the environment the Netwrix software will also have to monitor systems in Microsoft Azure, Microsoft 365 and onsite systems. This includes items such as Exchange online, Onedrive, Sharepoint online and a number of virtual machines operating out of Microsoft Azure.
- 2.7 The Azure Virtual Machines include Domian controllers, Windows Servers, Application servers and Azure Virtual Machines.
- 2.8 The onsite environment is utilising Microsoft Hyper V technology. There are Microsoft Windows Servers onsite.

  - iv) If the specific goals have been claimed or obtained on a fraudulent basis or any of the conditions of contract have not been fulfilled, the organ of state may, in addition to any other remedy it may have –
    - (a) disqualify the person from the tendering process;
    - (b) recover costs, losses or damages it has incurred or suffered as a result of that person's conduct;
    - (c) cancel the contract and claim any damages which it has suffered as a result of having to make less favourable arrangements due to such cancellation;
    - (d) recommend that the tenderer or contractor, its shareholders and directors, or only the shareholders and directors who acted on a fraudulent basis, be restricted from obtaining business from any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years, after the *audi alteram partem* (hear the other side) rule has been applied; and
    - (e) forward the matter for criminal prosecution, if deemed necessary.
