MULTI-DISCIPLINARY PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO THE INDEPENDENT DEVELOPMENT TRUST FOR STRATEGIC INFRASTRUCTURE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME FOR THE PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS WITH AN OPTION TO EXTEND FOR FURTHER TWO (2) YEARS

Expressions of interest (EOI) are hereby invited from suitably and qualified Multi-disciplinary professional and stakeholder management service providers for the provision of infrastructure professional project and stakeholder management services within the Independent Development Trust for the period of three (3) years with an option to extend for further two (2) years. The professional and stakeholder management service providers are invited to submit EOI's to provide all-inclusive services based on the work package deliverables detailed within this EOI. Only bidders with demonstrable knowledge and experience within the identified domains will be considered.

The services entails provision of engineering support, project management and stakeholder management services in the implementation and delivery of social infrastructure to IDT on behalf of various client government departments. Bidders will be evaluated in three (3) different stages as provided below:

STAGE 1: ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

In order to be considered for this expression of interest, tenderers must meet the following mandatory requirements in order to be considered for this bid:

- Proof of National Treasury Central Supplier Database (CSD) registration. Bidder will be required to have compliant status at the time of appointment.
- Valid tax certificate with tax complaint PIN.
- Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act (COIDA Certificate) Or the Federated Employers Mutual (FEM Certificate) or Rand Mutual Assurance (RAM certificate).
- 4. Fully signed and Completed all Standard Bid Documents (SBD) forms (SBD 1 and 4).
- 5. Recent/Latest three year signed Annual Financial Statements (AFS).
- Submit CV and certified Qualifications for Professionally Registered Company Director (at least one director must be registered with SACPCMP)
- 7. Copy of the Joint venture agreement signed by both parties (where applicable).8. Signed authority to sign on behalf of the bidding entity (i.e. Signed by the company director)
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Only bidders who passed all the above mandatory requirements will be considered for functionality evaluation stage.

STAGE 2: FUNCTIONALITY EVALUATION

Bidder will be evaluated on functionality as follows:

Only bidders who obtained minimum of 70% under functionality evaluation will be considered for price and preferential points evaluation.

STAGE 3: FINANCIAL PROPOSAL

The final award selection for all proposals which met minimum functionality threshold of 70% will be made through a combination of the achieved financial and specific goals score for each bidder in accordance with the relevant South Africa's National Treasury legislations and IDT Procurement Policy.

IDT reserves a right to appoint more than one (1) service providers which will be guided by the evaluation outcome.
