**REQUEST FOR QUOTATIONS FOR
PROVISION, INSTALLATION AND
MAINTANANCE OF DOOR INTERCOM.**

1. Purpose

- 1.1. The Railway Safety Regulator (RSR) requires the services of a suitable service provider to provide, install and maintain door intercom system with audio and video.

2. Considerations/background

3. Scope of work / Specification

Specification for an office door intercom system with integrated audio and video camera is as follows:

- Installation of office door intercom system, with cameras, transmitting to three destinations(substation) and ability to open from three different points (interlinked and integrated).
- The doorbell with three transmission channels inside and outside the door. Affixed to the adjacent wall.
- The doorbell with three different opening pads destination (If possible affixed to wall /dry wall
- Camera outside the door on the eye level (1,7). Affixed to the wall.
- Camera inside the door, on the wall on the eye level (1,7 m)

- Three transmission destinations with camera viewing pads/facility.
- Three destinations (number 7 above) able to release/open the door.
- Installation of the above in one door on one floor.
- Quote must include **3-year maintenance and service routine plan** after installation.
- The product/s must be ICASA approved.

Below it is just an illustration. Two of similar type interlinked.



The service providers are invited to a compulsory site / office inspection at the RSR.

NB: Failure to attend site/office inspection will lead to disqualification.

- 3.2. Comprehensive quotation (prices must be VAT Inclusive)
- 3.3. Tax Pin & Tax clearance certificate
- 3.4. Fully Completed and signed Standard Bidding Documents (SBD) forms documents
- 3.5. A valid BBBEE certificate or sworn affidavit (on sworn affidavit indicate the day, month and year of the financial year period ie, 31 March 2022)
- 3.6. Valid company registration documentation that are issued by Companies & Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC)
- 3.7. A Copy of the identity document of the company owner(s)
- 3.8. Valid Medical Certificate
- 3.9. Valid South African Social Security Agency (SASSA) registration **(Where applicable)**
- 3.10. Valid National Council for Persons with Physical Disability in South Africa registration (NCPDPSA)

Failure to submit valid documents listed above (No - 4.5, 4.6, 4.7, 4.8, 4.9, 4.10) for proof of claim specific goals as stipulated in Section 6 below will lead to the service provider not being awarded points for specific goal.

4. Evaluation 80/20 Preference Point System

- 4.1. The price quotations will be evaluated in accordance with the pre-scripts of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA) and its regulations, in particular Preference Procurement Regulation 2022 which stipulate **80/20 preference point system for acquisition of goods or services with Rand value equal to or below R50 million (inclusive of all applicable**

tax).

4.2. A maximum of 80 points for price and 20 points for the specific goal specified on the request for quotation may be awarded to a Service Provider.

4.3. Points for the specific goal will be awarded as specified on the table below:
