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5. SCOPE OF WORK

Purchase, Collect and Remove 132/22KV 20MVA transformer at Eskom Rotek Industries Serial no. T2770-2

The purchaser must assure the site be left clean at completion of their collection and removal of the goods.

The scope of work will include the purchase, collect and remove 132/22KV 20MVA transformer at Eskom Rotek Industries Serial no. T2770-2. Buyers must show their interest to participate by submitting all tender returnable specified on the tender enquiry.

The purchaser will be responsible for the safe collection, handling, removal, and transportation of the scrap.

It remains the responsibility of the buyer to be fully familiar with the condition of the 132/22KV 20MVA transformer Serial no. T2770-2 before tendering. Disputes regarding the condition of the items after tender closing will not be accepted or allowed.

The purchaser will be responsible for the safe collection, handling, removal, and transportation of the used transformer oil as well as to clean the site, qualified labour and suitable certified plant, machinery, equipment and transport for this purpose.

Payment shall be made to Eskom no later than five days after the date of the sale. The release of the equipment/scrap to the new buyer will take place after receipt of payment to Eskom and the buyer acquiring a permit to remove and transport the equipment/scrap.

The goods on sale will be identified by Eskom.

NOTES

- a. Eskom will not be responsible for any damages or losses suffered during the removal of the equipment incurred while working on this project arising from theft, damage or personal injury.
- b. You will be required to adhere to the condition as laid out by the Eskom site agent with regards to site access etc.
