Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

The iSimangaliso Wetland Park Authority invites tenders to bid **FOR AMPHIBIOUS DREDGING AND VEGETATION CLEARING WITHIN THE MSUNDUZI RIVER AND BEACH CHANNEL SYSTEM.**

The following tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, or are capable of being so registered prior to the evaluation of submissions are eligible to submit tenders:

- Contractors who have a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered for **6CE OR HIGHER** class of construction work; and
- Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that:
 1. every member of the joint venture is registered with the CIDB;
 2. the lead partner has a contractor grading designation in the **6CE OR HIGHER** class of construction work; and
 3. the combined contractor grading designation calculated in accordance with the Construction Industry Development Regulations is equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered for an **6CE OR HIGHER** class of construction work.

The following pre-qualification criteria applies to this tender:

- Contractors must have a CIDB contractor grade of at least grade **6CE OR HIGHER**

The tender will be evaluated on functionality/quality, and the following quality criteria are included:

Criteria	Weight
Methodology and approach	30%
Relevant experience	30%
Equipment suitability	30%
Skills transfer plan	10%

The Employer shall evaluate the remaining responsive tenders using the tender using Method 2: Financial offer and preferences. Tender evaluation points for preferences will be allocated as indicated on Form SBD6.1 in the Tender Document.

In terms of the PPPFA Regulations an organ of state can apply pre-qualifying criteria to advance certain Designated Groups. The prequalification is in align with the PPPFA Regulation as well as Transformation Approach that has been adopted by iSimangaliso Wetland Park. The following pre-qualification criteria for preferential procurement, Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022 applies to this tender:

- Tax pin
- CSD (Central Suppliers Database Full Report)
- CIDB registration, minimum 6CE
- B-BBEE Status or Sworn Affidavit
- Complete all SBDs initial and signed
- Company Registration Documents
- Letter of Good Standing
- Two Year Financial Statements.

Tenderers who are contractors with have access to the plant and have suitable experience FOR AMPHIBIOUS DREDGING AND VEGETATION CLEARING WITHIN THE MSUNDUZI RIVER AND BEACH CHANNEL SYSTEM for the iSimangaliso Wetland Park are invited to tender.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the iSimangaliso Dredger Harbour Offices, St Lucia, 3936, on **26 May 2026 AT 10:00**. The Tenderer shall inspect and examine the Site and its surroundings and shall satisfy himself before submitting his tender as to the form and nature of the Sites, the quantities and nature of the work and materials necessary for the completion of the Works and the means of access of the Site. The tenderer must be represented at the site inspection by a person who is suitably qualified and experienced to comprehend the implications of the work involved. Attendance of the site inspection is compulsory, and a tender will be disqualified if the site inspection is not attended by a representative of the tenderer.
