Tender Overview



Scope:

- Supply and delivery of valves and related components on an “as and when required” basis

Contract Term:

- 5 Years

Sites:

- All Peaking Power Stations

Closing Date:

- 02 July 2026 at 10:00 (SAST)

Submission Method:

- Electronic via Eskom eTendering Portal

Tender Validity Period:

- 180 days from closing date of tender

Tenderers must:

- Meet eligibility criteria
- Submit a complete tender (technical, commercial, financial)
- Submit all mandatory returnables including:
 - ✓ Completed NEC contract and pricing schedule
 - ✓ Excel price list
 - ✓ CPA for local goods / CPA(IG) for imported goods, where applicable
 - ✓ Local content declarations (SBD 6.2 and Annexures G1–G4)
- Ensure all documents are submitted in the correct format via eTendering
 - ✓ All tender documents must be submitted in PDF; the price list must be submitted in both PDF and Excel.
 - ✓ No hard copy or zipped submissions will be accepted.
 - ✓ Upload limit: 500MB per document and 4GB in total.

Clarification Period:

- Queries must be submitted in writing to the Buyer
- Queries must be submitted 5 working days before the tender closing date
- Responses will be consolidated and issued via clarification/addendum
- No queries will be accepted after the deadline

Minimum Functionality Threshold : 70%

Refer to ITT (pages 9–10)

Technical Area	Requirement Description	Weighting
Documentation	Complete and compliant technical submission aligned to ITT requirements	40%
Experience	Proven experience in supply of similar valves and components	30%
Delivery Capability	Ability to deliver across multiple sites within required timeframes	15%
Risk / Delivery Plan	Demonstrated supply continuity and mitigation of supply risks	15%

Pricing must be submitted in:

- Completed NEC pricing schedule (PDF)
- Excel price list

Prices must include:

- Delivery to site (DAP)
- All applicable costs

Pricing structure:

- Fixed for the first 12 months
- Adjustments applicable thereafter in terms of the contract

NEC3 Supply Contract applies

- Contract duration: 5 years
- Supply on an “as and when required” basis
- Each purchase order forms part of the contract

Key NEC Provisions

- **Delivery:** Supplier responsible for DAP delivery to various peaking power stations
- **Standards:** Goods must be manufactured, handled, packaged and transported in accordance with applicable safety, environmental and quality standards
- **Documents:** Delivery must include packing lists, invoice copy, delivery note, and test results / maintenance manuals, as applicable
- **Performance:** On-time delivery is important; deliveries must align to the relevant purchase order

The following requirements apply as stipulated in the ITT:

- **SDL&I Requirements:**
 - Supplier obligations relating to supplier development and localisation

- **Safety Requirements:**
 - Compliance with Eskom safety standards and applicable legislation

- **Quality Requirements**
 - Compliance with Eskom quality standards and technical specifications

- **General Compliance**
 - **Adherence** to all ITT and contractual obligations
 - Mandatory requirement: CSD registration

Note: Contractual requirements are not evaluation criteria and will be assessed after evaluation and ranking, prior to contract award.
