The tenders will be adjudicated via two stages of which the first stage will be functionality, and the second stage will be 80:20 Preference Point systems where 80 is for the price and 20 is for the preference goals. Each bidder must score a minimum score for functionality to be considered for the second stage of evaluation.

The Johannes Phumani Phungula Local Municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest, or any bid, either wholly or in part or give any reason for such action. If the price offered by tenderer is not market-related the municipality may not award the contract to that tenderer and may negotiate for market related price with the tenderer, failing which negotiate with the next highest scoring tenderer or the tender may be cancelled.
