DESCRIPTION: REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR AN INTRUSION ALARM SYSTEM AND CONTROL ROOM MONITORING SERVICES AT PetroSA SITES IN MOSSEL BAY

1. INTRODUCTION

The Petroleum Oil and Gas Corporation of South Africa (PetroSA) requires the service of an accredited South African Intruder Detection Association (SAIDSA) and PSIRA-registered security intrusion alarm service provider.

The Service Provider shall provide and maintain a comprehensive electronic security and alarm system for the property to enhance security and safeguard the premises, assets, and occupants.

The system shall be capable of remote monitoring and response to mitigate the risk of theft, vandalism, unauthorised access, and other security-related incidents.

The system may include, but is not limited to, intrusion alarms, motion detectors, beam sensors, door and window contacts, panic facilities, and any other appropriate security features required to ensure effective protection of the property.

2. GENERAL

Tenderers will be required to conduct a site assessment to evaluate the adequacy, condition, and suitability of the existing security system in meeting PetroSA's security requirements. Based on the assessment, tenderers shall submit a detailed proposal outlining their findings, identifying any gaps or deficiencies, and recommending the enhancements or upgrades required to ensure an effective and

fit-for-purpose security solution. The proposal should clearly describe the proposed improvements, their associated benefits, and any additional equipment or services required.

PetroSA has scheduled a **compulsory Scope Clarification Meeting for 11:00 on 28 July 2026, followed immediately by a site inspection**. Suppliers wishing to attend must notify the PetroSA representative by **14:00 on 27 July 2026** and provide the names and ID numbers of all attendees to facilitate the arrangement of site access permits. Attendees will be required to produce their original identification documents upon arrival to gain access to the site.

The areas where the systems must be installed are at the following sites:

- West Camp, GTL Refinery, Duinzicht Avenue, Mossel Bay
- Centre of Excellence, Bill Jeffrey Street, Mossel Bay
- Bartelsfontein Reservoir – Herbertsdale Road
- Danabaai repeater station – Flora Road, Dana Bay

3. SCOPE OF WORK

- It is required that the system be monitored by the Supplier on a twenty-four (24) hour basis
- Alert PetroSA Security Operational Room of any alarm intrusion for the sites, indoor as well as outdoor sites within the Mossel Bay area.
- Provide maintenance and support for the alarm systems on a need- and job-card basis.
- Each area must be able to arm and disarm the alarm by means of remote control, keypad or other method.
- Each area must have an outdoor siren
- Any other miscellaneous items needed to ensure the operation of the alarm system.
