



Technical Evaluation Criteria
NTCSA - Northern Grid for a period of 36 months

Qualitative Technical Evaluation Criteria are weighted evaluation criteria used to identify the highest technically ranked tenderer after determining that all the Mandatory Evaluation Criteria have been met. The Qualitative Evaluation Criteria are weighted to reflect the relevant importance of each criterion.

The minimum weighted final score (threshold) required for a tender to be considered from a technical perspective is 80% where all individual thresholds are adhered to.

Technical Scoring Methodology Score Percentage (%)

5	100%	Fully compliant – Employer's Requirements are met
4	80%	Compliant – Employer's Requirements are met.
3	60%	Partially compliant - approximately 50% of requirements met
2	40%	Minimally compliant
1	20%	non-compliant – requirements not met

1.Driver training certificates (Dangerous Goods, spill response) issued by Service provider registered with Department of Transport (DoT)	
2. Waste transport permits and municipal approvals – including a Tremcard (Transport Emergency Card) compliant with SANS 10232-4	
3.Use and access of licensed hazardous waste management facilities (Waste management license, registration certificates for the facility).	
4.Valid Professional Driving Permit (PrDP) with Dangerous Goods	

NB: Failure to comply with the mandatory requirements will result in the automatic disqualification of the tender.

Such tenders will not be considered for further evaluation.
