Scope of Work

Preparation of payment certificates and project close-out documentation.

Certified copies of Identity Documents of all directors, owners, members or shareholders. Municipal rates clearance in one of the following forms: (A municipal rates account in the bidder's name showing no arrears older than three (3) months; or A valid municipal rates exemption letter; or where the bidder is leasing premises: A valid signed lease agreement; and A municipal account in the landlords' name). Fully completed and signed MBD forms contained in the tender document. Certified CETA Level 5 LIC or CETA Level 7 LIC certificate for the Director or team members.

Evaluation Criteria

Bidders must obtain a minimum functionality score of **60%** to qualify for further evaluation on price and specific goals using the **80/20 preference point system**. Specific Goals are as follows; Locality, disability, black women and black youth, where all are allocated 5 points.
