DESCRIPTION OF THE WORKS: REMOVAL, DESIGN, SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF BBC PERIMETER FENCE FOR TRANSNET SOC LTD (REG.NO1990/000900/30) OPERATING AS TRANSNET PORT TERMINALS (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS "TPT") AT THE PORT OF DURBAN POINT CAR TERMINAL (MPT), AGRI-PORT TERMINAL AND MAYDON WHARF TERMINAL.

Question Number	QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
Q1	Would previous experience gained on general building projects be considered acceptable for evaluation purposes where such projects included work of a similar nature and scope to the fencing works required under this tender?	The technical team confirmed that such experience may be considered, provided that the bidder clearly demonstrates the similarities between the previous project and the current scope of work. Bidders must specifically highlight the fencing-related works, concrete works, or other relevant activities undertaken as part of the general building project.
Q2	Can bidders provide additional annexures if the space provided is insufficient?	Yes. The table provided in the tender document is intended as a summary. If the space is insufficient, bidders may replicate the table or attach additional annexures, provided they follow the same format and clearly present the required information.
Q3	The tender documentation specifies a minimum CIDB grading of 7SQ or 7GB. Will bidders holding a higher CIDB grading also qualify for consideration?	The Project Manager confirmed that the stated grading represents the minimum requirement. Bidders possessing a CIDB grading of 7SQ or 7GB, or higher grading within the applicable class of works, will be eligible for consideration.
Q4	Where a bidder has completed projects under NEC contracts and does not possess appointment letters, but instead has signed contracts and completion certificates that do not necessarily reflect project values or durations, will the submission of a signed Form of Offer and Acceptance together with a completion certificate be accepted as evidence of previous experience?	The technical team advised that the matter requires further consultation between the Technical Evaluation Team and Supply Chain Management. A formal response will therefore be included in the consolidated Questions and Answers document to be published on the National Treasury eTender Portal and the Transnet eTender Management Portal.
Q4	Final Answer for question 4	After further consultation between the Technical Evaluation Team and Supply Chain Management it was concluded that the bidders need to ensure that references provided comply with the requirements on returnable T2.2-05: Evaluation Schedule: Previous Experience Which states that: Tenderers are required to demonstrate performance in comparable projects of similar size and nature by supplying the following: 1. A list of past / current comparable projects.

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		2. Construction of similar works as detailed in the Works Information with reference to: • Previous Experience of Palisade Fencing and/or High Security Fence installation conducted by tenderer, or their partner / subcontractor. References to provide letter of reference, to be traceable and contactable to allow verification of track record provided. • Sufficient references to substantiate experience indicated (Client name and contact details, project description, duration, and contract value) • Submit a signed with a customer letter head. NB: Bidders to note that signed contracts and completion certificates and a signed Form of Offer will be additional supporting documents to the requirements under the returnable schedule T2.2-05: Evaluation Schedule: Previous Experience
Q5	Does Transnet publish tender prices submitted by all bidders, making them available for viewing by participating tenderers?	It was clarified that Transnet publishes the details of the awarded bidder together with the contract value of the successful tenderer. The pricing information submitted by unsuccessful bidders is not disclosed.
